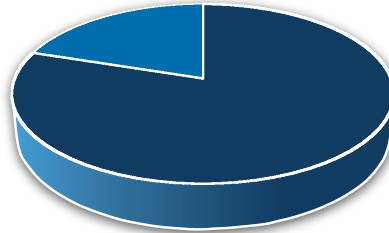


Corporate Card Survey Results

- 21% No



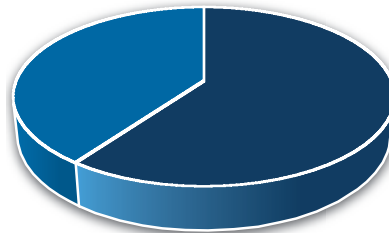
Please rate your satisfaction with your issuer's current policy compliance reporting.

- 39% Unsure



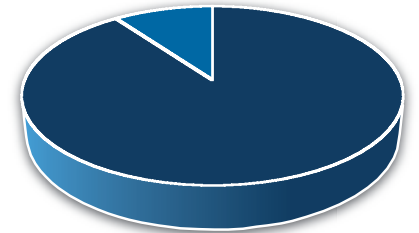
Would you be more likely to increase spend as a result of automated controls? If so, by how much would you grow your program?
