Enable Effective Crisis Response and Future Resiliency



Provide a trusted foundation for decision-making. Reinforce public trust by ensuring data is of high quality, complete, and fit for use, so that decisions are based on the best information available.



Optimize contact tracing. Help states, cities, and schools reopen by using contact validation and address cleansing to ensure data is of high quality, complete, and accurate.



Guard against improper payments and application fraud. Ensure data quality and enable a 360-degree view of recipient data including address, phone numbers, and past benefit claims.



Prevent supply chain disruption. Obtain a single view of all supplier data to monitor supplier data, detect anomalies, and accelerate decision-making.



Ensure data privacy. Shield personally identifiable information in accordance with the law, identify where data is stored, and guard against unauthorized data access.

Take a Multi-Focused Approach to Crisis Response

Informed decision-making depends on having access to real-time data. During a natural disaster or a pandemic, conditions can change rapidly. And allocating and distributing resources require a 360-degree view of a situation as soon as possible.

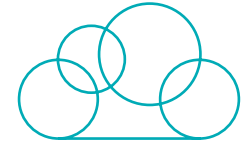
